1. LETTER RECEIVED REGARDING A FUTURE PLANNING APPLICATION

The Chairman stated that the clerk had received correspondence from Peter Humphrey Associates Limited regarding a planning application for 63 houses on land adjacent to High Road, Wisbech St Mary. This has not yet been submitted to Fenland District Council Planning, but Mr Humphreys requested that perhaps the Parish Council would like to have some input before the plans were finalised and submitted to the planning authority.
