1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE Cllr J Newland, Cllr J Fish.

2. TO SIGN AND APPROVE MINUTES OF MEETING dated 12th February 2018

The minutes were taken as read, agreed as a true record and signed by the Chairman.

3. MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES (information only)

- (a) Planning application F/YR17/1217/F The Clerk read a response from FDC that it had not been scheduled for committee and if officers were minded to recommend refusal it would fall within the scheme of delegation given the Parish recommendation.
- (b) Bus Route 46

The Clerk read responses from both Stagecoach and CCC to the effect that CCC are investigating options which included how much it would cost to replace the service. Cllr Davies commented that if the service had to be lost an option may be to reroute the X1 service.

(c) The Clerk reported that CCC has replied that the report of a missing Bus Stop sign opposite The Bridge Inn had been actioned. Cllr Humphrey said the sign had not been replaced.

7. HIGHWAYS MATTERS

(a) Street Lighting

The Clerk reported that he and Cllrs Britain and Wheeler would meet with Electrical Testing Ltd 19 March to agree the final proposals for the future management of the lighting stock. It was agreed that the following would be discussed: units needing replacing, units awaiting replacement, one additional unit, timescales, the way forward for the future – minor defects reporting, replacements and new units. It was agreed that units would be replaced with new as dictated by their condition, it would be useful to know what minor repairs are required and how urgent those repairs are. A summary report by good, fair, bad condition would enable budgeting over several years. It was proposed by Cllr Knight seconded by Cllr Patrick that the proposals be adopted. **Agreed unanimously**

8. FINANCE MATTERS

(a) To receive a Budgetary Control Report(BCR) for 2017/18 to date

The Clerk circulated the BCR and drew attention to the Income and Expenditure figures to date and to the Bank Reconciliation. Cllr Davies commented that in view of the high expenditure this year caution must be exercised next year. The Clerk confirmed that Capital commitments had been reviewed and agreed as shown. **Agreed**

(b) To receive the allotment account statement for 2017/18

The Clerk circulated the Statement and confirmed that all income had been received. **Noted** It was proposed to review rents in August 2018. **Agreed**

(c) Internal Audit arrangements

The Clerk reported that Auditing Solutions Ltd would carry out the internal audit 24 April 2018. Noted

Cllr Mann left the room for the duration of this item.

The Clerk reported an invoice handed to him by Cllr Mann at the last meeting. The three items had been discussed at previous meetings but there had been no resolution regarding costs and payment consequently he could not present them for payment. Following discussion it was agreed that the arrangement had been misunderstood. Cllr Knight proposed that as the work had been carried out as required and at reasonable cost on this occasion payment should be made, seconded by Cllr Allen. **Agreed unanimously**. It was noted that in future it any costs must be clearly identified prior to work being carried out. **Agreed**

9. PARISH PROPERTY

(a) Maintenance

i) Guyhirn War Memorial – railings quotations

The Clerk reported quotations: Stackwell Forge £2870 (no vat) and Artistic Metalica £2310 (plus vat) It was proposed by Cllr Davies seconded by Cllr Allen that the Artistic Metalica quotation be accepted. Agreed unanimously

- ii) The Clerk confirmed that suppliers had agreed to undertake the maintenance contract for a further year with no increase in rates.
 - (b) Bus Shelters

It was agreed that the new shelters would be added to the maintenance contract. The frequency and specification for cleaning would be discussed at the next meeting.

- (c) Defibrillators Nil
- (d) Planters
- (i) Cllr Knight explained that the Wisbech St Mary Play Group proposed to revamp a landscaped area which would include planters. It was agreed that they could submit a grant bid which would be considered in the usual way.
- (ii) Cllr Knight asked if the planter could be moved to under the Murrow sign. A quotation would be invited from Bowles Tree & Garden Services. It was proposed by Cllr Humphrey seconded by Cllr Knight that it be moved. **Agreed unanimously**
- (iii) There was discussion regarding a fence that had been extended across a North Level District IDB drain. It was agreed to notify the planning enforcement officer, request North Level IDB to take action to have it removed, and notify CCC as it obstructs driver visibility as they approach a bend.
- (iv) ClIr Britain reported that MAC's had requested a sponsorship sign including their logo. It was agreed; that a logo was unacceptable as signs should be consistent, that ClIr Scrimshaw would ask the new occupier of The Bell Inn if they wished to sponsor the planter, and that sponsors should be responsible for cleaning signs.

10. PARISH COUNCIL WEB SITE

Cllr Knight reported good progress and had emailed a link to the site to all councillors prior to the meeting. He considered Tamar IT Ltd had done a good job in progressing the site to first draft within two weeks.

It was agreed that agendas and minutes should be in pdf format, so they could not be copied and changed. More photographs are to be added. Cllr Knight will publicise the new site in Village Voices. The Clerk reported that the final payment was due.

Tamar IT Ltd – stage 2 and final costs for web site £420.00 Local Government Act 1972 s.142 Cllr Allen proposed that the payment be approved, seconded by Cllr Patrick. **Agreed unanimously**

11. REPORTS FROM DISTRICT AND COUNTY COUNCILLORS

Cllr Booth reported:

- (a) Local Highway Improvement bids were to be considered 13 March. Both schemes had scored highly.
- (b) Cllr Seaton had been elected the Leader of FDC.
- (c) FDC had agreed a council tax increase of 2%

Cllr King reported:

- (d) CCC are to investigate the flooding outside the shop at Wisbech St Mary.
- (e) Some street light repairs will be done shortly, others require work by UK Power Networks.
- (f) There will be a new initiative to reduce road traffic collisions and injuries.
- (g) In response to a question by CIIr Davies CIIr King reported that several CCC officers had visited Cants Drove, he was awaiting a report of options for repairs.
- (h) In response to a question by CIIr Davies CIIr King agreed to visit The Gull, opposite Tall Trees Leisure Park as the first entrance from Murrow had half the carriageway obstructed by overgrown vegetation.
